



Conference on Best Teaching Practices using ICET

December 22 and 23, 2008

The conference aims to provide a platform to the teaching community to demonstrate and share teaching practices using ICT tools and techniques that they have found to be highly effective. This event also provides a forum for the teachers to forge synergistic relationships within the teaching fraternity so that students' learning can be impacted positively. The conference will try to bring a research orientation in all activities involved with teaching.

Who can apply?

- In-service teachers from any field handling K-15 in India.
- Pre-service teachers from any field training to handle K-15 in India.

Key Criteria of Proposed Teaching Practice:

The teaching practice must show how well technology has been utilized to add significant value to the teaching-learning process. Technology includes ICT tools such as PCs, laptops, handhelds, data loggers and sensors, i-Pods, computer software, Internet and any related gadgets/software.

Procedure:

1. Submit a paper in English not exceeding 6 pages describing the teaching strategy. The paper should contain the following:

Paper Title

*Author Name(s) & Affiliation(s)

Author Address for correspondence with email id & phone number

Abstract

Keywords

Main Paper

References

You can use pictures/screenshots/diagrams for clarification. The paper should highlight how you have integrated technology such as computers, sensors, etc. into your strategy.

2. The paper will be reviewed by a panel of experts and if accepted, information of acceptance will be sent to the email id specified.

3. On receiving acceptance email, **register at the conference website and send your hardware and software requirements for demonstrating your strategy in the conference.

4. Present paper at the conference on specified data and time. All papers presented will receive certificates of participation.

* If your paper has more than one name, only one person can participate in the conference.

** Registration is free and includes lunch and refreshments on conference days. Registrations are not transferable. Registration does not include accommodation or travel expenses.
