

Procedure and Rules – BTPC 2008

- Submit a write-up in English not exceeding 6 pages describing the teaching strategy. You can use pictures / screenshots / block diagrams for clarification. Your report should highlight how you have integrated technology such as computers, sensors etc. into your strategy.
- Once your write-up has been accepted, you will be informed of the same.
- After you receive the acceptance intimation, you are required to register at the conference website and send your hardware and software requirements for demonstrating your strategy in the conference.
- Registration is free and includes conference material and lunch and refreshments on conference days.
- Registration does not include accommodation or travel expenses.
- If your entry has more than one name, only one person can participate in the conference.
- Registrations are not transferable.
- Entries will be judged on their pedagogical merit, originality, how extensively has the practice been tried out and used by the teacher, and feedback – both qualitative and quantitative – from the student community.
- Contest judges have been chosen based on their familiarity with education and instructional practices, technology and experience. **All decisions made by the judges are final. No correspondence in any form will be entertained once the decision has been communicated.**
